Fyrisgården arranges leisure activities for people of all ages. There are many activities and groups. Feel free to join them if you wish, or just tell us if you have other ideas. Maybe many others are interested in the same activity, and we can set up a new group.

What can you do at Fyrisgården?

Fyrisgården lodge in a big house with many rooms. Some of them are:

- A room with weaving looms
- Carpentry
- Sewing room
- Creative studio
- Several kitchens where you can cook and bake
- A large room suitable for dancing and acting
- A café where you can relax and socialize
- Two music studios where you can play instruments, compose and record music.

Among Fyrisgården's groups you find:

- Needle work
- Carpentry for children
- Theater
- Lego construction
- Dance for people with disabilities.

Do you have other interests or dreams that you want to fulfil? Please, talk to us at Fyrisgården! There might be a way we can start a new group for your activity.

Fyrisgården also has several activities for people with disabilities. It goes without saying that we welcome everybody to our house, regardless of disabilities. But we also find it very rewarding for people with disabilities and other people to meet and get to know each other.

How is Fyrisgården run?

Fyrisgården is an independent association. That means that the members decide at the annual meeting what Fyrisgården should do. The members chose a board every year, and the board has the overall responsibility. The everyday business is handled by the manager Ulrica and her staff. It is not expensive to become a member – only 100 Swedish Skr a year for one person, and 150 Skr for a family.

Where can I find Fyrisgården?

Fyrisgården is located at Svartbäcksgatan 58, by river Fyrisån, within walking distance from Uppsala city center. You can easily come here by foot, by bicycle, by bus or by car.
